90° Cart Rule for Winter

For the winter season we would like all cart drivers to use the 90° cart rule when driving in the fairways. Please stay on the cart paths as much as possible then to 90° to your ball and 90° back to the cart path.

The outstanding condition of the fairways during the summer allows the convenience of driving carts down the fairways. With the winter colder temperatures the fairways go dormant, the ground freezes and thaws, and there is more danger of root damage and soil compaction. Thus, there is a need for less cart traffic on the fairways. Please help us maintain our fairways over the winter by using the 90 rule. If we all do this, the fairways will be as good as ever this spring and summer.
